Sometimes, people just need more time to get to the heart of their recovery.

With daily counseling and a variety of therapies and healthy activities, Extended Care provides the chance for people to learn and recover in their own time within a beautiful, serene, supportive environment.

While the duration for Extended Care treatment depends on the individual, the National Institute on Drug Abuse notes that most addicted people need at least three months in treatment to significantly reduce or stop their drug use. The best outcomes occur with stays of 6 to 12 months.

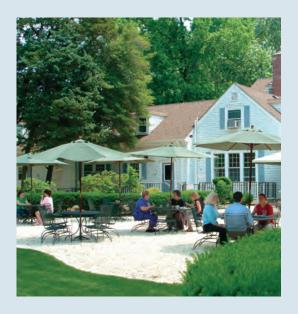
